














### What Can I Do as a Parent?

- Be available to talk openly with your teen about his/her problems.
- Get involved in your teen's life. Support your children's activities by attending special events, like recitals and games, and praising them for their efforts.
- Make clear rules and limits and enforce them consistently.
- Make sure it is clear to everyone where your teen can go, what activities you
  approve of and who they can and can't spend time with.
- Help your teens choose their friends wisely. Get to know your teen's friends and their families.
- Educate yourself about alcohol, tobacco, and drug use before talking to your children. You will lose credibility if you don't have your facts right
- Talk to your children about drugs. Short discussions go a long way. Engage your teens in conversation. Ask what they know, how they feel, and what they think about the issue.

### A Pledge for Parents

As parents and citizens, we will talk to our teens and the teens in our lives about the dangers of drug abuse. We will set clear rules for our teens about not using drugs. We will set a good example for our teens by not using illegal drugs or medicine without a prescription. We will monitor our teens behavior and enforce appropriate consequences, so that our rules are respected. We will encourage family and friends to follow the same guidelines to keep teens safe from substance abuse.
